



## CHAMPION Open Window Die Press

The Champion Open Window Die Press OP is a punch press type of machine for cutting windows in envelope blanks. It has an extremely heavy crank shaft, very strong slide connections, long, well-gibbed slides and a simple, reliable clutch. It is operated by a foot treadle, and cuts a 3/8" to 1/2" stack at every stroke. A strip of heavy paper fed from a roll moves automatically 1/16" after each stroke across a celluloid block to furnish a fresh cutting surface. A heavy nut adjustment in front of the ram will raise or lower the

die with great precision, leaving no excuse for cutting below the paper strip. Thus the bottom blank is cut as cleanly as the top one. About 16 feet of paper are used for every 250,000 blanks cut.

All regular sizes of straight side dies (1½6"x2%" to 2½8"x5%") can be used in this machine and they are quickly and easily changed. Information on special size dies (thumb-cutting, etc.) will be furnished on request.
