Re: Medi-Therm (MTA 6900 & 7900) Discontinuation

As you may be aware, Stryker acquired Gaymar Industries and the Gaymar temperature management products in 2010. Since that time, the Stryker Patient Handling account managers have been conducting surveys of the temperature management equipment including the hyper/hypothermia systems in facilities throughout their territories. They have discovered that several pieces of equipment are outdated and in desperate need of replacement. I wanted to take this opportunity to list the Stryker hyper/hypothermia systems that are obsolete.

As of 2013, Stryker closed the manufacturing facility that houses Medi-Therm and all remaining inventory was depleted at the end of September, 2013. Medi-Therm models that have been discontinued are MTA6900 & MTA 7900. These units have been in place for many years, with most now being 10-15 years old. Parts routinely required to support this equipment are difficult to obtain and in some cases, not available at all. However, support and service are still available.

Please note that we are depleting Medi-Therm disposable part numbers HP7010 and HP7020, with no new production planned. All other Medi-Therm disposables will not be affected. The system will interface with the traditional Gaymar hypo/hyperthermia blankets that you are familiar with, as well as the Rapr.Rounds body wraps. All related products remain readily available with no delay in delivery or availability.
