The machine available is a 2013 model and is excellent condition. It has been used as a demonstration machine and is supplied with a 3:1 Pitch Wire Die.

The MagnaPunch 2.0 has an evolutionary paper edge detection system which eradicates any paper waste, it will not punch unless the paper is aligned correctly. This model as a LCD interface which delivers real-time error reporting, such as overload of paper warnings. Operator instructions and set up are built in so anyone can use this model.

The MagnaPunch 2.0 is the faster punching machine in its class, using a ½ second punch cycle it is capable of punching 49,000 sheets per hour. Punching can be performed via a foot pedal or trigger switch which is located on the paper guide for ease of use.

13 interchangeable punch dies are available for many different binding styles such as wire, coil, comb, proclick and surebind/velobind. A 2/4 hole punch die is also available for any loose leaf requirements.
